**Step-2:** Click **Conference program** from the menu and then click the join link as circled in the figure

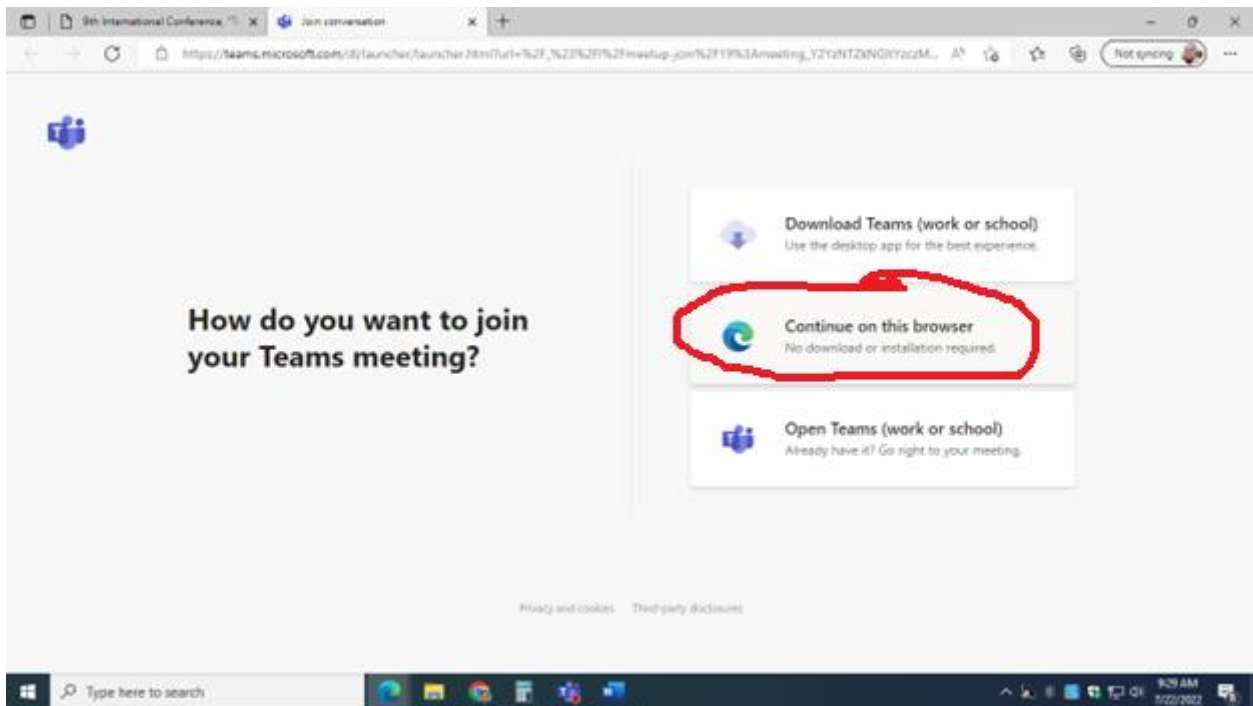

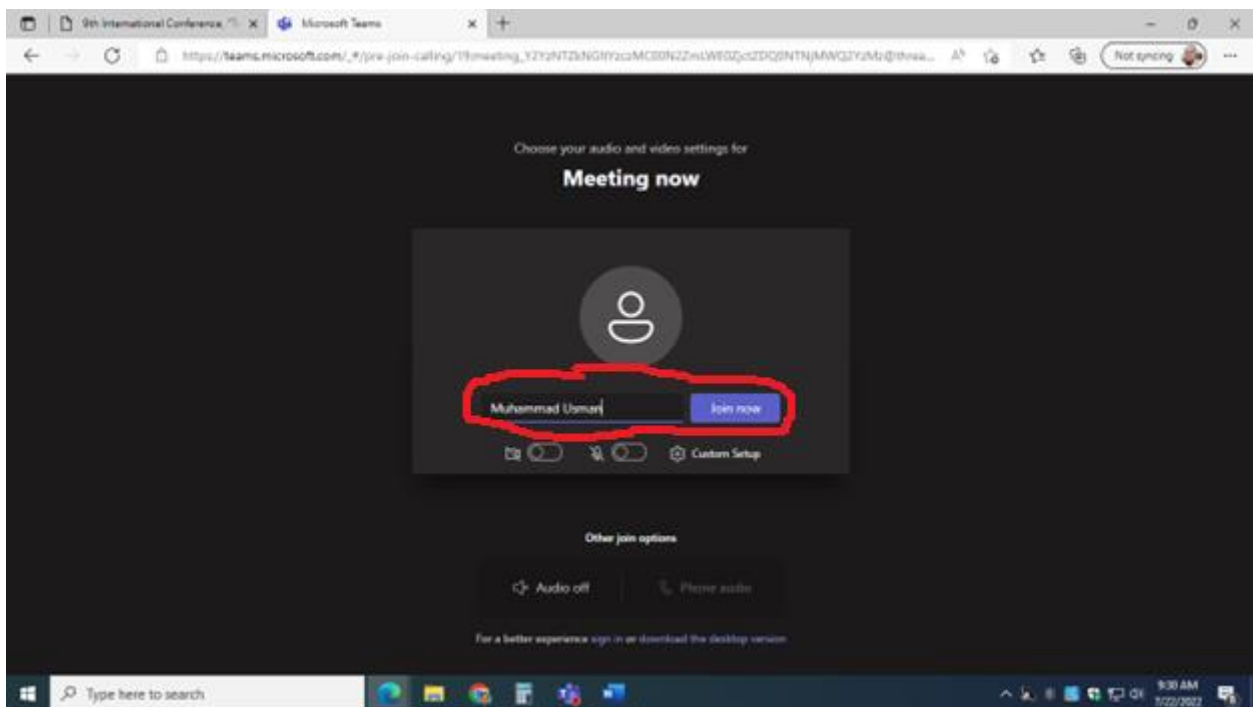

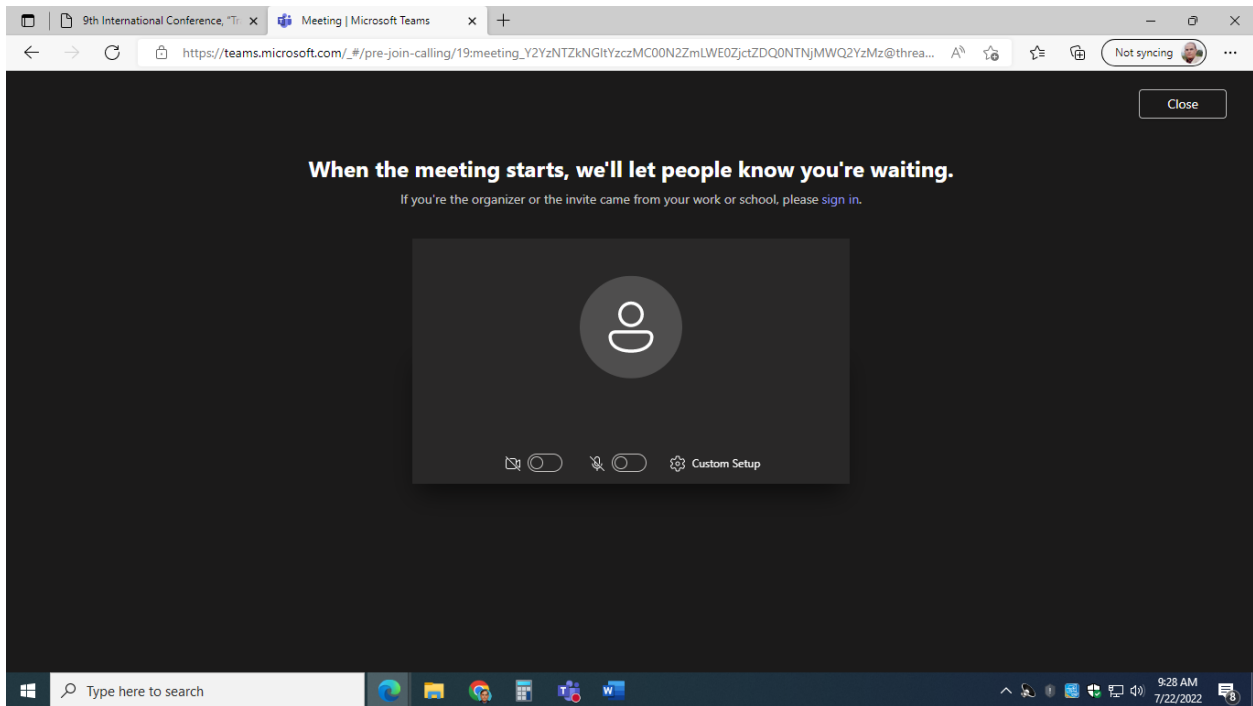
**Step-4:** Click **Continue on this browser** as circled in the given figure
